

PHOTO CONTEST – OFFICIAL RULES

1. Eligibility: All photos submitted must fall within the following four categories:

- Nature/On-the-land
- People/Places
- Community Events
- Harvesting

Contest is open to everyone, except employees of Inuvialuit Regional Corporation. Photos must be taken in the Inuvialuit Settlement Region or include an Inuvialuit subject. All photos entered will become the property of Inuvialuit Regional Corporation and, if required, an original file of the photo submitted may be essential for consideration of entry into the Photo Contest.

2. Agreement to Rules: By participating, the contestant (“You”) agree to be fully unconditionally bound by these rules, and You represent and warrant that You meet the eligibility requirements. In addition, You agree to accept the decisions of Inuvialuit Regional Corporation as final and binding as it relates to this Photo Contest.

3. Campaign Period: Entries will be accepted through email and Inuvialuit Regional Corporation’s Facebook, Instagram and Twitter accounts. The contest starts on Wednesday, March 1, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. MST and ends on Monday, May 1, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. MST.

4. How to Enter: You can enter the contest through the following two ways:

Email: Send your photo(s) to comms@inuvialuit.com (max file size: 9 mb).

Social Media: Submit your photo(s) on Inuvialuit Regional Corporation’s Facebook page or by tagging @inuvialuitcorp on Instagram and Twitter and including the hashtag #Inuvialuit.

For each photo entered, please indicate the category for which it is being submitted. You may submit as many photos as you wish.

5. Prizes: THREE (3) winners will be selected from each category, for a total of TWELVE (12) winners. Winners in each category will receive the following prize:

First Prize

- Gas gift card (VALUE: \$50)
- Inuvialuit Regional Corporation jacket (VALUE: \$100)

Second Prize

- Inuvialuit Regional Corporation hoodie and extras (VALUE: \$75)

Third Prize

- Inuvialuit Regional Corporation Prize Pack (VALUE: \$50)

If located outside of Inuvik, the winner’s prize will be mailed to a provided address.

6. Winner Selection and Notification: Winners will be selected by a group of four Inuvialuit Regional Corporation employees, who will select the winners for each category based on popular vote. Winner will be notified through their email or social media profile the week following the conclusion of the Photo Contest. If Winner cannot be contacted or is ineligible, the prize may be forfeited and an alternate winner selected. Winner must supply the original photo of their winning entry before prize will be made available.
