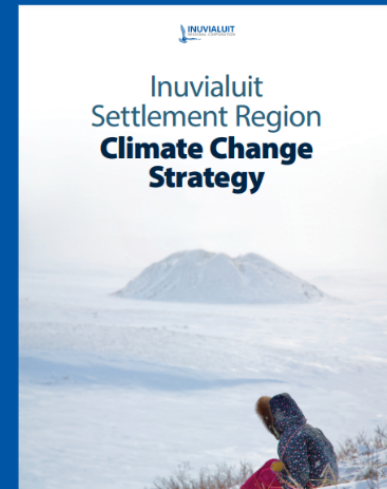


Youth Involvement in the Implementation of the Inuvialuit Settlement Region (ISR) Climate Change Strategy

ISR Climate Change Strategy

The ISR Climate Change Strategy summarizes a wide range of impacts that an increasingly warmer and wetter climate will bring to the ISR. It also describes a multi-faceted course of action toward climate change mitigation, adaptation, and resilience across the region by implementing six thematic areas and their associated goals. The six thematic areas of the ISR Climate Change Strategy are food & wellness, safety, housing & infrastructure, education & awareness, ecosystem health & diversity, and energy. It is essential to recognize that Youth play an integral role in implementing each thematic area's goals and actions, as they are invaluable contributors to climate action.

Job Description: Assist the Climate Change Program Coordinator.



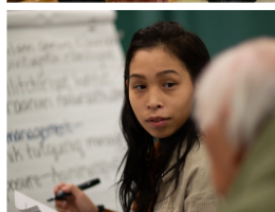
