More clarity overall in how the proposal will be evaluated would be greatly appreciated.

Answer:

Preference will be given to Inuvialuit-owned businesses, including sub-contractors and local representation. However, full value-based evaluation will be conducted to create the highest possible benefit to the IRC and its beneficiaries
