

#### Introduction

Climate change impacts on the Arctic environment have sparked unprecedented growth in climate change research being conducted in Arctic communities across the globe. Continued advancements in these research areas have resulted in increasingly more sophisticated and specialized terminology being used. As a direct result of the advancements in scientific terminology, information relayed to ISR communities has become increasingly difficult to comprehend, both conceptually and linguistically. Consequently, the gap of understanding between Inuvialuit knowledge and the scientific community has continued to increase over time, creating an unfortunate disconnect between researchers and ISR community members. This disconnect has prompted ongoing terminology work to develop standard climate change, energy, and environmental terminology in all three dialects spoken across the ISR.




Figure 1: Inuvialuktun Dialects across the Inuvialuit Settlement Region

Sallirmiutun, Uummarmiutun, and Kangiryuarmiutun, collectively known as the Inuvialuktun language, are the three dialects spoken in the ISR (*Figure 1*). The Inuvialuktun language is spoken by fewer than 50 percent of the population, many of whom are Elders. As the "true" holders of Inuvialuit Traditional Knowledge, Elders are often interviewed for numerous research and oral history initiatives/projects. Not surprisingly, language revitalization, Inuvialuit Traditional Knowledge sharing, and cultural heritage preservation are becoming increasingly important in Inuvialuit self-determination and identity. It has also become an effective vehicle through which Inuvialuit can navigate through the influx of academically driven information coming into ISR communities.

#### Workshops

Since 2019, the Inuvialuit Regional Corporation has worked successfully to compile a Glossary of terms related to climate change, clean energy, and the environment through translation workshops with Inuvialuit Elders (see Table 1 for the terms translated). Translators from each of the six ISR communities, fluent in each of the three Inuvialuktun dialects attended the workshops. Inuvialuit Youth have been invited to attend recent workshops to observe and participate in translating the terms. At these workshops, translators provided translations and the literal meanings of climate change and long-range contaminants-related terms (Table 2). There is plan to translate another 19 terms at future workshop. This Glossary of terms will help to reduce confusion, minimize inaccuracies in interpretation and facilitate easier communication between Inuvialuit communities and researchers. Additionally, the glossary will promote greater community involvement in climate change adaptation and resiliency planning, policy development and future research across the ISR, while empowering Inuvialuit to exercise their cultural responsibilities through on-the-ground stewardship initiatives on their traditional lands, waters, and ice.
