Inuvialuit elders to receive benefit payments to help offset cost of living

Inuvialuit Regional Corporation is pleased to announce that all Inuvialuit beneficiaries **60 years of age and over** (884 in total) will be issued a benefit payment of \$500 on December 1, 2024. The benefit is made possible by the interest income of the \$442,000 Inuvialuit Social Development Fund and was approved by the IRC board of directors at its November 19-21 meeting held in Inuvik.

Due to the current Canada Post strike, elder beneficiaries are strongly encouraged to get set-up with direct deposit before December 2, so they don't experience a delay in receiving payments.

How funds will be distributed:

- For elders registered with IRC Enrolment for direct deposit, payments will be deposited directly to their bank account on December 1.
- For elders **not registered for direct deposit,** community corporations will be distributing benefit cheques in each Inuvialuit Settlement Region (ISR) community the week of Dec 2.
- For elders living outside the ISR cheques will be mailed once the strike has endedplease ensure your mailing address is up to date with IRC Enrolment.
