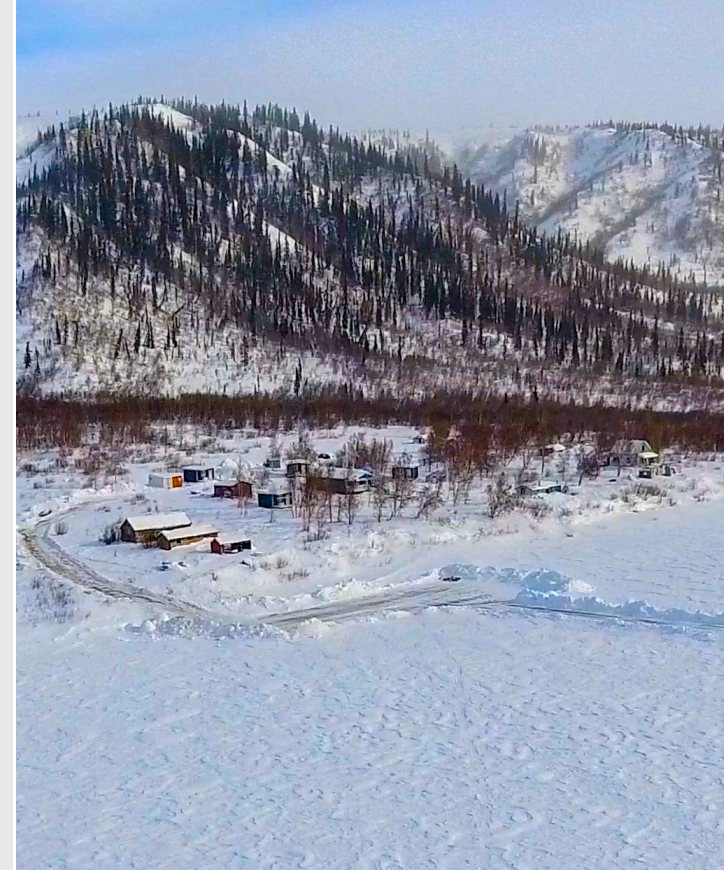

About ISET

To support the growth of Indigenous communities and to foster lifelong learning and skills development, the Government of Canada has committed to the creation of the Indigenous Skills and Employment Training (ISET) Program.

The Inuit Labour Market Strategy (ILMS) is a distinctions-based strategy under the ISET Program. The ILMS reflects the Government's commitment to a renewed relationship with Inuit.

The goal of the programs ISET funds is to ensure Inuvialuit beneficiaries have the opportunity to earn an education and contribute to their local economies in meaningful ways.

What can ISET provide funding for?

- **Post Secondary Education:** Beneficiary support to attend approved post-secondary institutions in the ISR and beyond. Travel, tuition, books, supplies/materials, living/accommodation allowance, child care and completion bonuses.
- **Workplace Readiness:** IRC ISET works in partnership to deliver WPR courses based on need.
- **Training on the Job:** Provide a wage subsidy so that you can move into further employment or apprenticeship.
- **Youth Initiatives:** Work in Partnership to deliver programs to youth to prepare them for further education.
- **Other Programs:** IRC's Education and Training Division can work in partnership to design and deliver employment programs that are best suited to the needs of Inuvialuit.

How can I apply for ISET funding?

Contact or visit IRC's Education and Training Office to begin the application process.

Attend a preliminary interview to assess your education, employment and funding needs to determine which of our programs is right for you.

If ISET is right for you, we will assist you in completing a career plan, ISET application form, and next steps.
