

Call for Inuvialuit Member, Inuvialuit Arbitration Board

Inuvialuit Regional Corporation (IRC) is seeking applications for two members of the Inuvialuit Arbitration Board.

The Inuvialuit Arbitration Board has the jurisdiction to arbitrate any difference between the Inuvialuit, Industry, Governments of Canada, Northwest Territories or Yukon as to the meaning, interpretation, application or implementation of the *Inuvialuit Final Agreement* (“IFA”). It also hears appeals by individuals who have been denied eligibility or enrolment as a beneficiary of the Agreement.

Any member of the arbitration board should have a thorough understanding of the IFA and awareness of the economic and social conditions in the Inuvialuit Settlement Region (“ISR”)

Appointment and reporting structure

The IAB has eleven (11) members, including the chairperson and vice chairperson. Three (3) members are appointed by the IRC Board of Directors. **IRC is currently seeking applications to fill two (2) vacancies on the Inuvialuit Arbitration Board.**

Board members hold this appointment at the recommendation of the IRC Board of Directors for a term of three (3) years.
