

Federal Indian Hospitals Settlement



Summary of the claim

Compensation for survivors of abuse at Federal Indian Hospitals
The claims process is open until July 27, 2028.



Compensation range \$10,000-\$200,000 (based on abuse impact)
+ funds for healing, education and wellness

Who can apply?



Individuals who were admitted to Federal Indian Hospitals who experienced abuse while there between 1936 to 1981 and who are living or were alive on January 25, 2016.

If the person passed away after January 25, 2016, a claim may still be submitted on their behalf by their estate or heir to the estate.

How to apply

Gather: the claim form, personal and contact information, government-issued photo ID and information about being admitted to one of the 33 Federal Indian Hospitals.
