

Indian Boarding Homes Program Class Action



Summary of the claim

Compensation for individuals placed in private homes as part of the Indian Boarding Homes Program.

The claims process is open until February 22, 2027.



Who can apply?

To be eligible for compensation, a person must have:

- been placed in a private home during the period of September 1, 1951, to June 30, 1992, for the purpose of attending school, or after June 30, 1992, if Canada was responsible for their placement
- been alive on or after July 24, 2016

Every class member placed in a private home as part of the Indian Boarding Homes Program is eligible for a Category 1 payment of \$10,000.

Individuals who experienced harm, including physical, sexual, psychological or emotional abuse, neglect or loss of culture, language or family connections may apply for additional compensation. This is called a Category 2 claim and payments for this category range from \$10,000 to \$200,000.

How to apply

To submit a claims form, you must have:

- Photo ID: Up-to-date, photo copies of front and back of ID
- Beneficiary number
- Void cheque or direct deposit form from your bank
- Documents related to your time in a boarding home, such as letters, photos, diaries, attendance records or report cards
